## Summer Farm Toy Show Rules & Regulations:

1. The NFTM will follow all State, County, and Local regulations as preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, it cannot guarantee that its participants, volunteers, partners, or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19. While participating in events held or sponsored by the National Farm Toy Museum, participants acknowledge the risk associated with large indoor events and, by participating, will hold harmless the management & property owner (National Farm Toy Museum and Beckman High School) from any and all claims of loss, liability, and injury.
2. Displays cannot exceed 8'x8'. Size eligible for museum case display 72" long x 30" wide and limited to 50" in height. Tables are 8-foot in length. Exhibitors must furnish their table skirting/coverings for their display.
3. Judging: Judged Best of Show winners will be determined by total points based on the criteria below. People's Choice will be judged by submitted ballot on Saturday and awarded on Sunday.
4. Exhibitors are required to be set up by 9:00 am on Saturday. The show manager must approve late arrivals or early teardowns before the show. Exhibitors must be able to have their booths set up on both days of the show.
5. Exhibitors accept total liability for any injury or loss to themselves, staff, or property while attending the Summer Farm Toy Show. The exhibitor expressly releases the management & property owner (National Farm Toy Museum and Beckman High School) from any and all claims of loss, liability, and injury.

### JUDGING CRITERIA (25 points each)

- Basic Construction - parts and elements to scale, level of detail, work quality, overall appearance authenticity.
- Story Line - there should be a theme or storyline. If the subject is historical, depict it accurately.
- Ground Work - all elements of buildings, roads, vegetation, terrain materials, vegetation, etc.
- Presentation - All elements should come together as a single, cohesive unit with no features or parts of features out of place within the diorama as a whole.
